This week we will continue to talk about food and gardening. We will also begin to learn the letter Oo.


This week's Letter Words:

Reading

In class we will soon begin to focus on some “Reading Skills.” Here are a few examples of what we will do and things you can try at home too!

- When we have story time, we will look at the pictures before we read and see if we can tell the story through the pictures.
- We will start playing a game where I will say a word slowly and the students will see if they can guess the word (“Let’s say a word. Say it slowly first. Listen to the sounds: C-A-T. C-AT. What word do you hear?”)
- When the students look at books alone they are learning to look at the pictures and now they will also look for simple words like “the, a, an, in, I, is, it” (not just letters!)
